

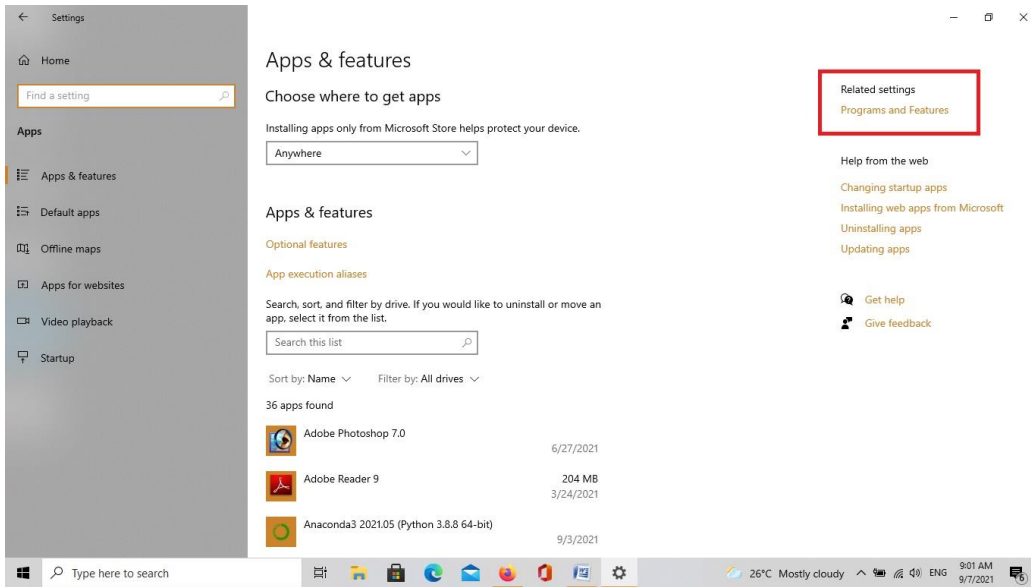


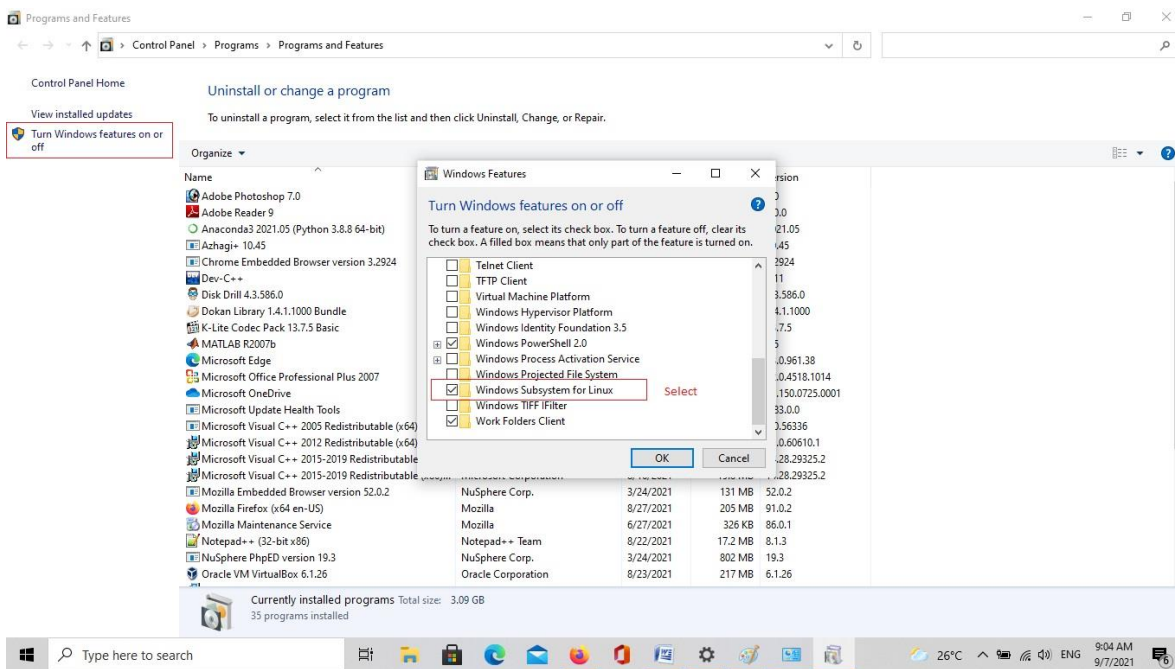
How to install Ubuntu on Windows 10 OS

Note: Before start install make sure your internet connection to the system.

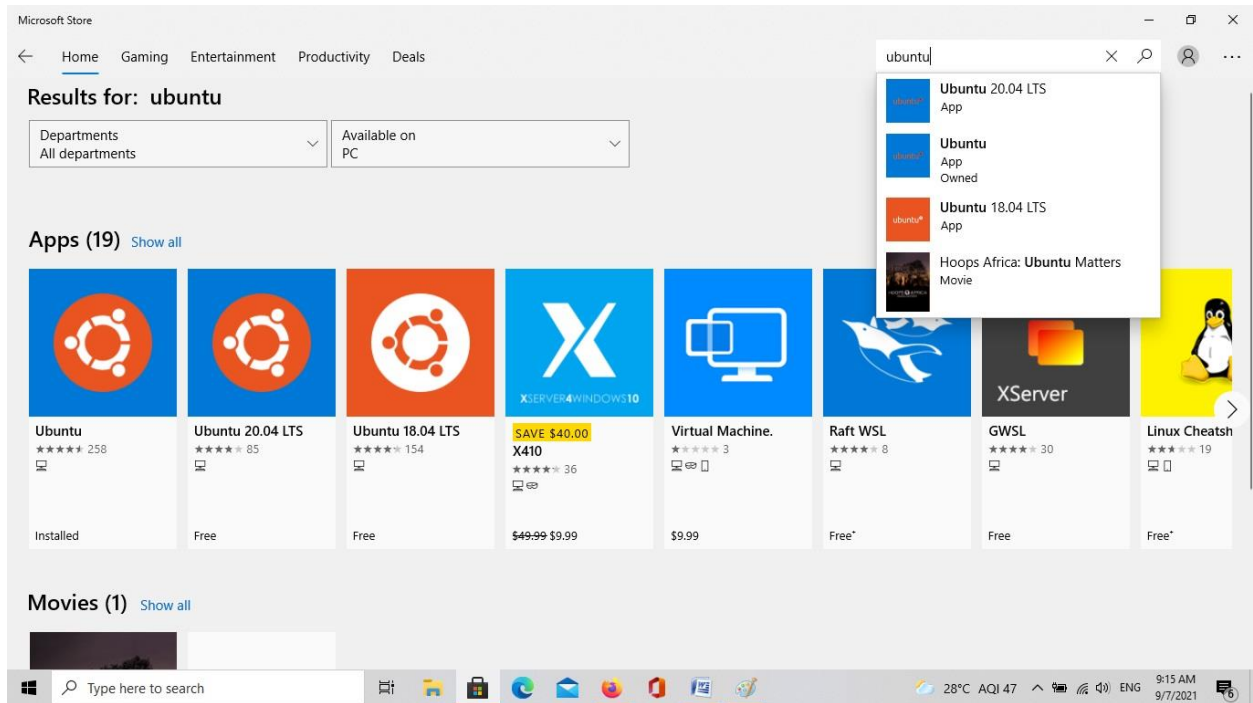
1. Click to Start  Button in Windows 10 and select the Settings  icon, then select Apps in setting window



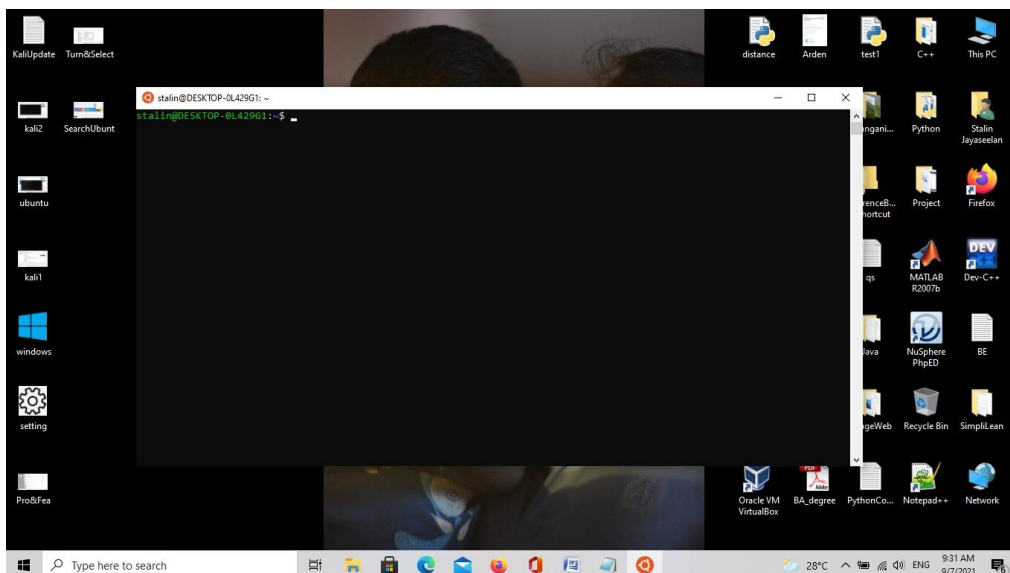
2. Select **Program and Feature** in top of the right corner.



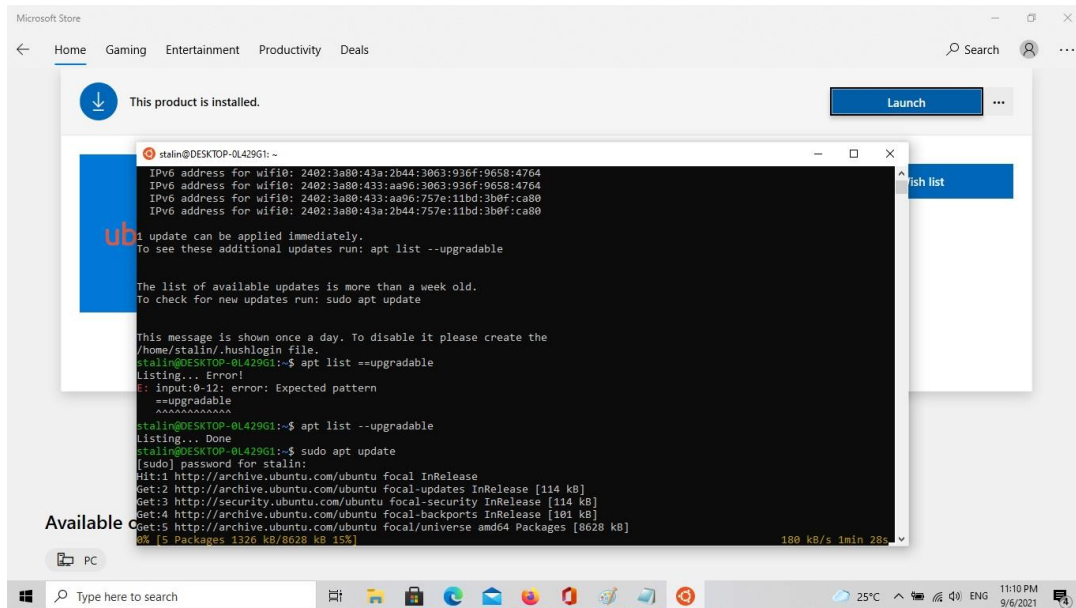
3. Turn on windows Feature to click the left top corner text. And windows Feature dialog box will open then select (checked check box) the **Windows Subsystem for Linux**. Ok to save.
4. Go run text box and type "Window Store" it will open as below and enter key word "Ubuntu" in search box.



5. If you already installed Ubuntu in your system U can select the Installed and Launch the Ubuntu. If you are going to download any one of the Ubuntu (free) download.
6. After installed, Window will show Launch the key word then click the Launch button on top right.
7. First time it will take some time and will come to ask your **Username: and Password**. Set user name and password (**Must be remember whenever you update the system will ask your password**)



- Then close the Ubuntu prompt, and go to run text box then type Ubuntu. It will open



- Update the latest version and using following comments

`apt list --upgradable`

It will show any updates are available, then use the following comment to update.

`sudo apt update`
